About "Tor Vergata" University

The conference organizer, the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" is the principal scientific advisor and coordinator of the Italian Ministry of Internal affairs with regard to the Italian eID card project. In this function the University designed the issuing infrastructure for Italian eID card and addresses the important question of standardization and cross-border interoperability. The University also developed the e-services of AGEA, an Italian government agency that distributes more than \$ 7 billion in EU agricultural subsidies to farmers annually. These projects involved the setup and management of certification authorities, a high security distributed eID issuing system and the development of the "cooperation backbone", i.e. a network infrastructure that supports the online cooperation of independently acting institutions in an environment that is secure, privacy preserving, and that guarantees accountability. Other national and international projects managed by the University of Rome "Tor Vergata" focus on digital identity, federated identity, the management of civil status records, and the long term preservation of digital documents and data.
